CIRCUIT AWARDS : Awards in all Classes. You must show in all classes offered to qualify.

PRACTICE PEN: Outdoor practice pen open daily. Practice in arena 6 am each day starting Dec 29th (Must be signed up the night before) Cost: \$40 for 4 minutes. Price doubles after 6 minutes. Practice works must be paid on separate check on file with practice pen prior to working.

STALLS: \$110 for Circuit. Must be reserved by Dec. 19th by calling Cindy Ingram (727) 856-6016 Stalls cancelled after 12/19 must still be paid for, used or not. First bedding included. Stalls available on Dec 27th at 8:00 a.m. No charge for stalled turn-back horses ONLY if pre-approved at office before show starts. Extra bedding available – Sign up for delivery at office. \$8/bag.

GROUNDS FEE: Horse not using stall, \$30 fee for circuit.

RV HOOKUPS: \$20/day. When you call for stalls, let us know number of RV slots needed. All RV reservations will be filled; however, locations are first come, first serve. If you park in front of an RV slot you will be charged for it, hooked up, or not.

NEW YEAR'S EVE: Dinner @ 8:00, followed by Award Presentations. Tickets available at the door. Adults \$20, Children under 15 yrs \$12. This is a BYOB event and FCHA will NOT supply alcoholic beverages.

Duties of exhibitors and/or owners: Have proof of current NCHA membership, have proof of Amateur/Non-Pro card (if applicable), have horse registration papers on file with office (or produce a copy before entry into a class), enter classes before draw, pay all charges incurred by end of show and before payout of winnings.

FCHA Year End Awards: FCHA memberships must be paid by the end of the show for that show's money to be counted for year-end awards. Example: If you show at the Winter Circuit, but do not pay your membership until the February show, only February's earnings will count towards year-end awards, not earnings from the Winter Circuit. It is the owner and exhibitor's responsibility to complete a membership card. You must show in 50% of the classes offered throughout the year to be eligible for year end awards.
